We will discuss the election process, and a Nominating Committee will be elected. This is your opportunity to shape the work we do for our community. It is important that you attend and participate in the election and goal-setting process.

1. On September 29, 2022, at 7 pm at Huntington Public Library (Station Branch), there will be an election of the Nominating Committee (between 5-15 members). All members whose memberships are current as of 30 days before the meeting date may be elected to the Nominating Committee (not more than 2 being unit officers).

2. On October 20, 2022, at 6 pm at the South Huntington Public Library, the Nominating Committee will report, have receipt of Nominations by Petition, and the election of the Election Supervisory Committee. All members whose memberships are current as of April 1st of the election year, whose memberships have remained continuous throughout the election process, and who live and/or work within the unit's jurisdiction may be nominated for office or as an at-large member of the Executive Committee. In order to sign a nominating petition or be elected to the Election Supervisory Committee, a member must be current as of 30 days prior to the October meeting.

3. On November 17, 2022, 6 pm at the Huntington Station Branch Library, elections will take place at the Huntington Public Library (Station Branch). Polls will remain open for at least 4 hours.
